

INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPLETE THE FORM FOR THE RESEARCH PROGRAM

 - (1) The performance in the interview, particularly, the questions on certain topic (for example: Physical, Inorganic and Theoretical) and
 - (2) The preferences you have provided in the research interest form.
- (c) For your own success and to enable us to provide you the best possible option, please complete all the columns in the form and, finally
- (d) You are welcome to visit the labs for additional information during your stay in the campus

A general suggestion is that, to get admission in the department, it would be wise for you to choose a broad area of interest in research, such as Physical, Inorganic or Theoretical. Please do not write "Sub-Topic" in the "research interest" form.
